Joint Resolution in Memoriam:

WHEREAS, the Legislature has learned with deep regret of the death of:

(1-1) the Honorable Kathy Irene Javner, of Chester, Representative of House District 29. A passionate follower of Christ, Representative Javner not only professed her faith but lived it daily. She and her husband Chris dedicated years of their lives to serving in Senegal, West Africa, where they founded Legacy International, a nonprofit that focused on vocational training and medical relief for malnourished children. A devoted educator, Representative Javner taught and mentored young people, encouraging her students to discover their passions, recognize their gifts and believe in themselves. Her commitment to service extended into public life. She served in the Maine House of Representatives from the 129th Legislature to the 132nd Legislature, 2018 to 2026. During her tenure, she served on the Legislature's Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources and Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services, of which she was the Ranking Member. She worked tirelessly for the betterment of children in foster care, our veterans and our older adults and in pro-life advocacy. Representative Javner will be long remembered and sadly missed by her family, friends, colleagues and community;
